Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2015-16 educational progress for Hemmeter Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2016-17 year, no new Priority or Focus schools were named; some Priority or Focus schools did exit their status because they met the exit criteria. New Reward schools were identified using school rankings and Beating the Odds information. A Focus school is one that has a large achievement gap between the highest and lowest achieving 30% of schools. A Priority school is one whose achievement and growth is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Reward school is one that has achieved one or more of the following distinctions: top 5% of schools on the Top-to-Bottom School Rankings, top 5% of schools making the greatest gains in achievement (improvement metric), or "Beating the Odds" by outperforming the school's predicted ranking and/or similar schools. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases no label is given.

Our school was identified as a Reward School by the State of Michigan. The staff at Hemmeter Elementary School is very proud of our exceptional program for gifted and talented students. It is our goal to prepare students

to be responsible, well informed citizens that have the skills necessary to compete in a global society. Through a plan for continuous school improvement, the implementation of the Common Core State Standards, and a focus on data-driven best practice instruction, we are confident that the students at Hemmeter Elementary School will continue to excel.

PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

School attendance boundaries are set by the Board of Education. All students meeting the academic testing requirements of this school are enrolled to attend. Students must demonstrate an IQ of 120+ on a national recognized and administered assessment. Out-of-district students apply through Schools of Choice.
