
## Meet George Seurat



George Seurat painted in a style called pointillism. Pointillism is art made by painting or drawing many layers of dots instead of lines and shapes. This painting is called "Sunday Afternoon on the Island of La Grande Jatte." If we look very close, we can see Mr. Seurat used ONLY dots of different colors to make this painting.

## Pointillism Artwork

Look out the window or go outside to create a landscape just like Seurat did! Include grass, trees, sky and more!

Using crayons, markers, paint and Q-tips, or even a pencil, draw a picture using only dots. The dots can be different sizes. They can overlap.
