We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2019-20 educational progress for the Hemmeter Elementary School. For the 2019-20 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not given a label. However, we were recognized as a National Blue Ribbon School for 2020.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

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PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

School attendance boundaries are set by the Board of Education. All students meeting the academic testing requirements of this school are enrolled to attend. Students must demonstrate an IQ of 120+ on a national recognized and administered assessment. Out Of District students apply through Schools of Choice.
