
Young Fives and Kindergarten Staff





Students visit the library/media center at least once a week. They are able to select books for pleasure reading and assignments or projects. Our titles are easily accessed through our automated system. Books are checked out for a one week period, but may always be renewed if the student wishes to. Overdue notices are sent to students once a book is 3 weeks overdue. We do not charge fines for late materials, however, if the book is lost or damaged, we will bill the student the cost of the damaged item. That item is then replaced. We ask that parents help their child in caring for books and materials and in returning them on time.

Title I Staff







Westdale Reminders

- *Breakfast and Before the Bell Programs begin at 7:10 a.m. each day. Students who are dropped off before 7:30 need to go to the gym. Hallway supervision begins at 7:30 a.m. each morning.
- *Attendance Procedures: When your child is absent from school be sure to call the school office (797-1827) and report the absent before 8:30 a.m. School begins at 7:45 a.m. Students who are not in their classrooms at 7:45 are considered tardy or absent. If the student arrives before 8:05, the student is marked "tardy." If the student arrives after 8:05, the student is marked absent for a half day.

School ends at 2:35. Students who are removed from class before 2:35 are recorded as LE (Left Early) or half day absent. If the student leaves within 20 minutes of dismissal, it is considered "LE". If the student leaves earlier than 20 minutes before dismissal, attendance is marked as "absent" for a half day.
