

On-Line Access to Student Meal Accounts


Are school mornings at your house chaotic? Have you ever had one of those days when you get to work and realize you forgot to give your child lunch money? Have you ever wondered why your middle school student is asking for more lunch money on Friday, when you just gave him/her \$20.00 on Monday?

On-line access to your child's school meal account allows you to monitor purchases, transfer funds between siblings and deposit money in your child's account with a credit card, all from your computer. On-line deposits are made directly to your child's school meal account and are available immediately. If you choose to make on-line deposits to your child's account, a processing fee of \$2.00 will be added to each transaction. One transaction may include deposits to several student accounts. Cash and check deposits are still accepted if you prefer to send money to school with your child.

To request on-line access to your child's school meal account, go to: www.stcs.org, follow the links to Departments, Nutrition Services, and On-Line Access Request. Complete and submit the form to request a login and password.

On-Line Free/Reduced School Meal Applications

If you experience a financial hardship at any time during the school year, feel free to apply for free or reduced price school meals. If you have a login and password to access your child's school meal account, you have access to our on-line free or reduced price meal application. If you do not have a login and password for your child's school meal account, follow the instructions above to request a login and password. If you do not have access to a computer, free and reduced meal applications are available at your child's school. Westdale students practiced Sport Stacking in Physical Education class during the month of November. Sport Stacking is an exciting individualized & team sport where participants stack & unstack twelve plastic cups in a predetermined sequence. Westdale students had a great time learning the different stacking combinations during class. We worked on the 3-3-3 and the 3-6-3 patterns.

Sport stacking helps students develop bilateral proficiency, which assists in equal performance on both sides of the body. By increasing bilateral proficiency, a student develops a greater percentage of the right side of the brain, which houses awareness, focus, creativity and rhythm. Stacking helps train the brain for sports and other activities where the use of both hands is important, such as playing a musical instrument or using the computer.
