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## A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF OUR SCHOOL

Hemmeter Elementary School houses the district's elementary talent development program. Students are accepted on the basis of ability and achievement scores.

## PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

School attendance boundaries are set by the Board of Education. All students meeting the academic testing requirements of this school are enrolled to attend. Out-of-district students apply through Schools of Choice.

## CORE CURRICULUM

The core curriculum is fully implemented and completely aligned with the state's model. The district's curriculum is fully aligned with the Common Core State Standards.

## THE STATUS OF THE 3–5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

The 2015-2016 Hemmeter Elementary School Improvement Plan was completed through a full comprehensive needs assessment. The Hemmeter School Improvement team, comprised of teachers, administration, and parents, meets regularly during the school year and collects data from multiple assessment sources. The School Improvement Team disaggregates the data, determines areas of need, and works collaboratively to develop best practice strategies to address the areas of need. All goals are specific, measurable, realistic, and time bound. Indicators of progress are determined through assessment data analysis to determine the effects of instructional strategies.
