

HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL

**Orientation/Registration: Wednesday, June 7 or Thursday, June 8 at 6:30 pm
Heritage Cafeteria (park in North Parking Lot - enter at Entrance "C")**

Immediately AFTER Orientation: Registration - requires full payment; Additional time for Questions/Answers

- Take classes to get ahead, audit for no grade, or to make-up credit (non-Heritage students)! Each class covers 1 semester of class work .5 credits. We advise a 2-class maximum (more than 2 classes requires counselor approval). **Fees:** 1 class - \$199, 2 classes - \$299. **Full payment is due at time of registration.**

- The **first day of class is Monday, June 12** and the **last day is Wednesday, June 28.** Summer School is held in Room 131 (North Hall). Best entrance is the North Entrance, Entrance "C."

- **Monday, June 12** Student's **login and password access will be available starting at 9 am.** Students can begin work at this time. Classroom 131 is open to students 9 am - 12 noon and 1 - 3 pm each day.

- All class assignments and quizzes are **online** using **Edgenuity.** Students follow and complete online assignments that have video instruction. To earn credit, a student needs to meet all deadlines and receive a minimum average score on **chapter tests and final exams** that must be taken in the classroom.

- Students will have internet access during classroom time with help available each summer school weekday from **9 am to noon and 1 to 3 pm each day.** Students are expected to work on assignments and quizzes on their own wherever they have internet access **online** using **Edgenuity.**

- **Credit** To earn credit, a student needs to meet all deadlines and receive a minimum average score on assignments, quizzes and tests. **Chapter tests and the final exam must be taken in the classroom.**

- **Grading/Auditing** Upon successful completion, students receive a **"P" grade** (passing) which is the recommended option. A "P" grade will not affect the student's Grade Point Average

A letter grade (A, B, C, D) may be chosen, but not recommended because it affects the students Grade Point Average (GPA). This must be decided at registration. Any change must be made with the Summer School Teacher by **Friday, June 16.**

A student may also choose to AUDIT the class for no grade or credit.

- Students taking **2 semesters** of the same class (not encouraged) will need to take both at the same time.

- All **Refunds** MUST be requested no later than **Tuesday, June 13.** No refunds will be given after this date.
